


Our Vision & Mission

Our ongoing work ...

At present, Parivar Society is directly supporting a network of 5,000 families in 750 women Self-help Groups (SHGs) and 2 Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) over 02 blocks of 2 districts of Uttar Pradesh through its support services and interventions. All interventions are undertaken in convergence and integration with relevant initiatives of NABARD and govt. departments and their various programs.

The organization is responsible for coordination and management of the field processes, and networking for leverage, convergence and strengthening of the CSO network through training and capacity building across the 4 districts of Uttar Pradesh (i.e. Ghaziabad, Hapur, Bulandshahar & Gautam Buddh Nagar).



SELF HELP GROUPS (SHG)

Self-help groups are informal groups of people who come together to address their common problems. One important characteristic of self-help groups is the idea of mutual support – people helping each other. A self-help group is a financial intermediary committee usually composed of 10 to 20 local women between the ages of 18 and 50.
